


Project 2000- Operation Uganda children at risk

Following their successful visit last year to the vocational training centre in Rukungiri, which is being developed through our on going millennium project, Mathew and Emma Gothard are returning in May to spend 3 months working with John and Alice Tumisime and Global Care to continue the building work.



The money raised by Project 2000 put the roof on this new building.


Matthew is a Civil Engineer and has been given a 3 month "sabbatical" by his company to project manage the construction of the new building.

Winterslow and Firsdow have raised in excess of £10,000, towards the project £5,000 of which has already been sent to Rukungiri to support some of the building costs of the project so far. A large proportion of the funds raised so far have been through the regular

contributions from many families in the village, supplemented by gifts from many village groups and fund raising activities.

We would like to ensure that when Mathew and Emma return, sufficient funds are available to essentially complete most of the outstanding building work. We need to raise a further £5000 to cover the costs of the building which they will be working on. The project is focused on helping young people in Uganda to learn a trade when they leave primary school, to enable them to support themselves and their families, and to form small business's to help the countries economy.
